## **Emergency Procedures**

**In the event of an emergency all shooting must cease immediately. The following actions should be taken;**

- Inform all other shooters on the range of the emergency by use of the air horns, mobile telephones or any other means.**
- Inform the range officer or one of the CPSA qualified safety officers of what has happened and decide which emergency services are required.**
- Contact the emergency services by dialling 999 via a mobile telephone. Explain what has happened and where you are located. Tell the emergency services to follow the Rue du Mont Herault to the end and then turn right and follow the track to the entrance of the shooting range.**
- In the event of a medical emergency ensure that the first aid representative attends the casualty as soon as possible.**
- Ensure that all traps are disarmed and batteries disconnected before the emergency services arrive.**

- **Shooters should ensure that their shotguns and ammunition is securely put away.**
- **Do not clear up the range until you have received permission from the emergency services.**
- **Ensure eye witnesses to the write down their observations as soon as possible after the event.**
- **Contact the CPSA and supply them with a full record of the event.**
